- Students reinforce and further their knowledge of other disciplines through the foreign language.
- Students acquire information and recognize the distinctive viewpoints that are only available through the foreign language and its cultures.

Spanish Standard 4-Comparisons: Develop Insight into the Nature of Language and Culture

- Students demonstrate understanding of the nature of language through comparisons of the language studied and their own.
- Students demonstrate understanding of the concept of culture through comparisons of the cultures studied and their own.

Spanish Standard 5-Communities: Participate in Multilingual Communities at Home & Around the World

- Students use the language.
- Students show evidence of becoming life-long learners by using the language for personal enjoyment and enrichment.
